Nordex Profile

- Nordex was established in 1985 in Denmark.
- In 1987 Nordex began production of largest series wind turbines in the world called N27/250.
- In 1997 Nordex developed one of the largest stall-controlled wind turbines (N60/1300).
- In 2000, Nordex installed the first 2.5 MW prototype in Germany.
- In 2010, with 25 years since its establishment, Nordex installed it's 4000th turbine.
- Today more than 5,000 Nordex wind turbines with a total rated output of more than 7,800 megawatts are already rotating in 34 countries of the world.
- Nordex is represented with offices and subsidiaries in 19 countries.

Nordex in Pakistan

- In 2009, Nordex was awarded the first project from FFCEL in Pakistan.
- In 2012, Nordex became the first international company to complete Pakistan's first ever wind energy farm with the Honorable President Asif Ali Zardari inaugurating the farm on 25th Dec 2012.
- The 50MW wind farm in Jhimpir (Sindh), will always be a milestone for Pakistan's emerging wind industry.
- The next two projects are about to be commenced, with a further two to be launched later this year.



Nordex – Vision for Pakistan

- Pakistan market is expected to grow during the coming five years.
- Nordex is keen in transfer of technology to Pakistan.
- Towers are currently being manufactured by Nordex's JV partner Descon.
- Nordex is placing special emphasis on developing local specialized human resource for wind energy sector.
